Ornamental Features:

Chartreuse Wiggles Hosta features dainty spikes of lavender tubular flowers with lavender stripes rising above the foliage from mid to late summer. It's attractive small textured narrow leaves remain chartreuse in color throughout the season. The fruit is not ornamentally significant.

Landscape Attributes:

Chartreuse Wiggles Hosta is a dense herbaceous perennial with tall flower stalks held atop a low mound of foliage. Its relatively fine texture sets it apart from other garden plants with less refined foliage.

This is a relatively low maintenance perennial, and is best cleaned up in early spring before it resumes active growth for the season. Gardeners should be aware of the following characteristic(s) that may warrant special consideration;

- Insects

Chartreuse Wiggles Hosta is recommended for the following landscape applications:

- General Garden Use
- Mass Planting
- Groundcover
- Border Edging

Plant Characteristics:

Chartreuse Wiggles Hosta will grow to be about 8 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 12 inches. Its foliage tends to remain low and dense right to the ground. It grows at a medium rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 10 years.

This perennial does best in partial shade to shade. It prefers to grow in average to moist conditions, and shouldn't be allowed to dry out. It is not particular as to soil type or pH. It is somewhat tolerant of urban pollution. This plant can be propagated by division.

This particular variety is an interspecific hybrid.
